

FLUTELINE Adjustable Footrest



Footrests help to relieve weight from your lower back and assist in improving your working posture. Footrests can also relieve pressure from the thighs allowing for better leg circulation, helping to prevent oedema and deep vein thrombosis.

There are two critical things to look for in a good footrest, these are:

Durability - Because pressure is applied on a footrest all day, it must stand up to being banged around and pushed on. For this reason, the materials used to make the footrest should be sturdy and the less plastic involved the better. Recommended by many Occupational Therapists and Medical Practitioners.

Adjustability - Because people come in all shapes and sizes, it is important that a footrest is highly adjustable to suit a user's personal preferences. Ideally the height and slope of the footrest can be adjusted at both the front and rear of the footrest.

These footrests are made in New Zealand from all steel framing with ribbed commercial grade carpet tiles on tread surfaces. The welded metal version has no assembly resulting in a stronger finished product. Their 5-year warranty is testament that these footrests are built to last. They are height and slope adjustable on all four legs, resulting in a large range of possible height/slope combinations and the real carpet tread feels great underfoot.
